

This set of CD's is read by the late news commentator, Harry Reasoner, who does a good job of presenting the various "voices" of Central America. Unfortunately the set is very Marxist biased presenting few contrary voices that have not been already comprised like the Dulles Brothers, or President Roosevelt with "his bully pulpit".
