I'm in a transitional phase where I'm not quite a beginner but not at a level to be intermediate. It is frustrating because either songs are too easy to play or too hard. I bought this hoping I'd find some songs that challenged me but were not too difficult. It seems the songs in this book are actually nice for someone like me. There are a few sharps and flats, but I'm not overwhelmed by a bunch of difficult notes (sharps can be difficult to play because many require only a half hole). But what I like best is the finger chart at the back of the book. They actually show a diagram of a recorder for each note with the holes filled in. This is nice than how they usually do it. I've been perplexed sometimes of the fingering position.

So I grew up with this music, and played recorder for about 45+ years now. I bought this to teach a child some of the tunes, and it is pretty good. The only problem is that there is no way to play one or two of the notes in "The Sound of Music" itself, unless someone knows a trick to play low B on a soprano or tenor recorder... Songs are probably best for an intermediate player.

My kids are 8 and 9, and they loves playing the Sound of music songs, and were having fun playing them while watching the movie! The songs are easy to play if you have recorder experience. Great buy!
